2. Complete at least 1 project from the chart about any book that you read this summer and be ready to share in the fall!

Do a web search on a book you read and complete an activity/project they recommend.	Has one of the books you have read been made into a movie? Watch it and compare to the book.	Write a new ending for one of the books that you read.
Create a model or picture of the character or the setting of the story.	Write a letter to the author of the book telling what you liked or didn't like about the story.	Create a comic strip of the book.
Create a new title and cover for the book.	Create a crossword puzzle about the book or a word search for your friends to figure out. Need help? Look on the Internet for a crossword or word search maker.	Re-tell the story to a friend or family member.
