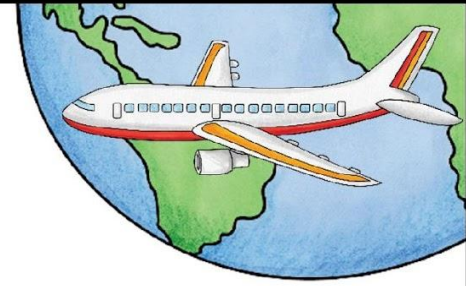
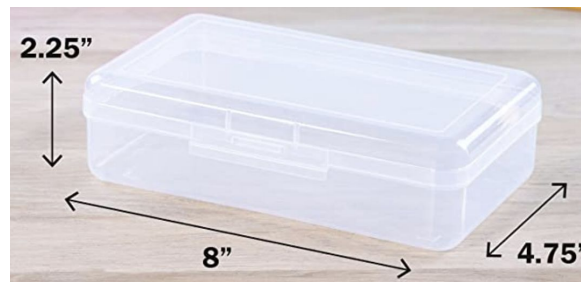


# SCHOOL SUPPLIES

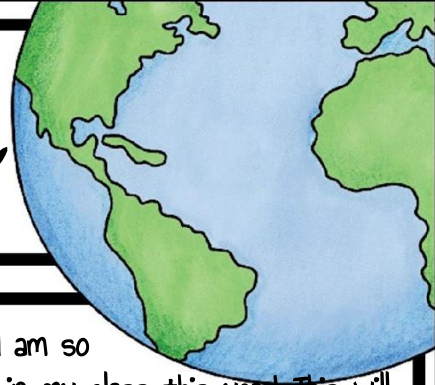
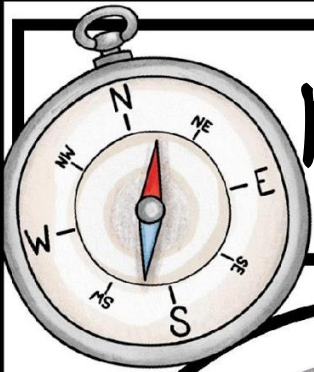


- 2 Large pink erasers

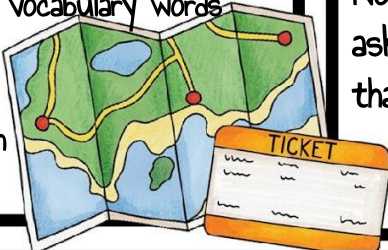
